Kingston Council would like Involve to be run by an organisation outside of Adult Social Care.



They think Involve should be independent from the council. This would help self-advocates to speak up about the council as well as other things.



Nicole Marcangelo has written a document saying what the council want from the new service



Over the next couple of months organisations will say how they can support Involve to continue their good work.

The council will decide which organisation is the best to run Involve.

They will talk to people with learning disabilities about this decision.

They will tell everybody who this is before the end of March 2018.



Involve may work differently but it will still speak up for people with learning disabilities in the borough of Kingston.

Involve will still work hard to make services better and to make changes in the community for people with learning disabilities.
